

Offshore crane operator reaction and awareness

Who should attend?

The course is designed for novice and experienced certified offshore crane operators who require additional training to deal with emergency situations.

What is the duration of this course?

- Crane pre-start / pre-operational checks and inspections
- Emergency procedures / emergency load lowering / crane operation limitations / individual operator's limitations
- Basic crane control / co-ordination in critical or emergency situations
- Ability to make the crane and load safe in critical or emergency situations
- The importance of effective communications and reporting procedures

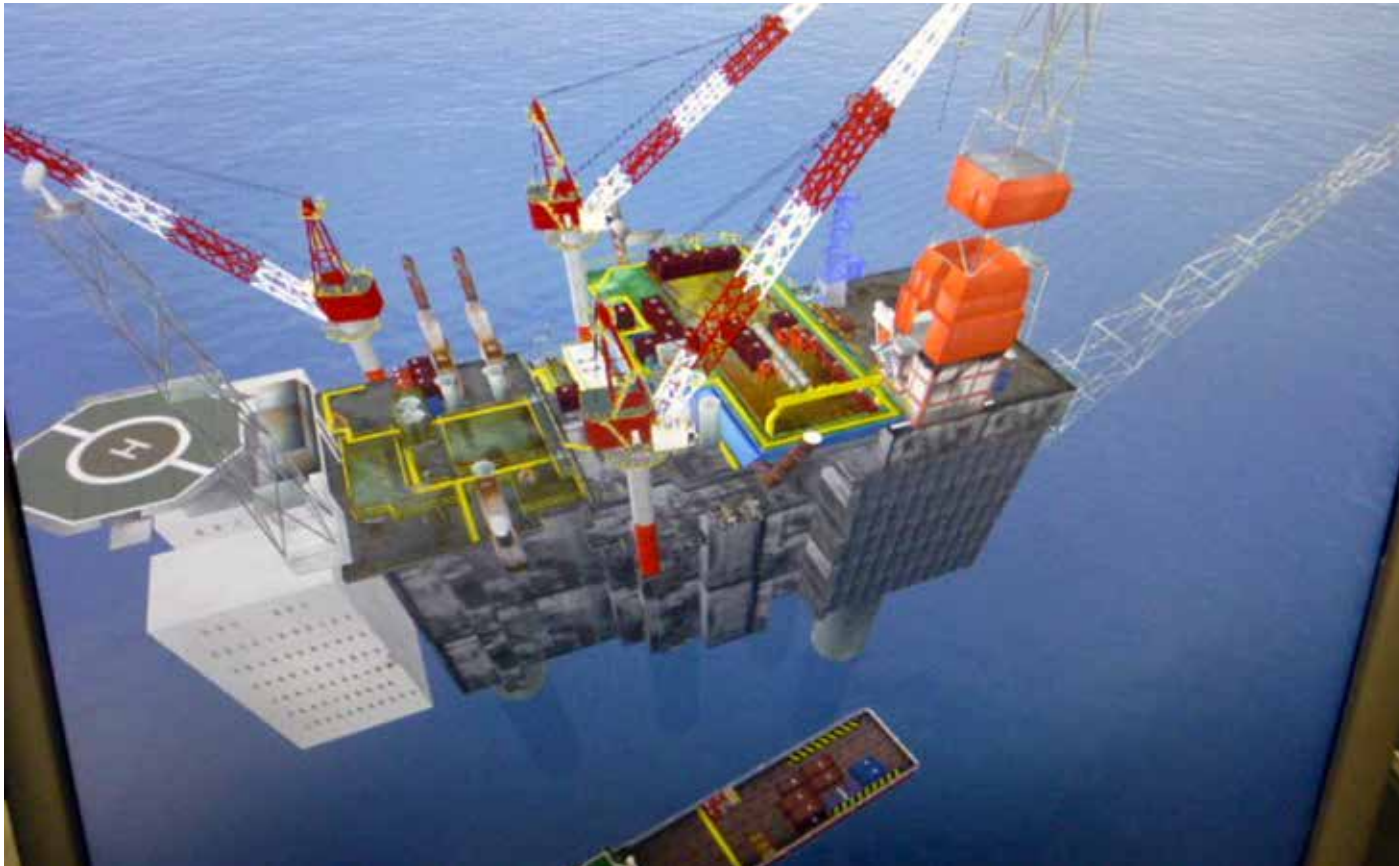
